Master Drawing List K10096-MDL, Revision A, dated April 10, 2012, or later FAA approved revision, with installation in accordance with Installation Instructions No. K-10096M, Revision B, dated May 9, 2012, or later FAA-approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of the other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft.

A copy of this certificate and the appropriate Installation Instructions must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

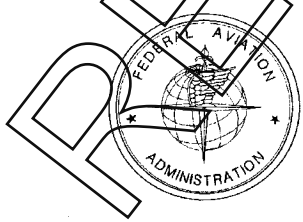
